

## **Report of the activities conducted for the year 2014-15**

- 1. Independence Day celebration:** MSW department and Srinivas Institute of Rural reconstruction Agency (SIRRA) organized Independence Day celebration at Padav Residential School for SC/ST. This school consists of 100 students especially from disadvantage sections of the society studying in I to VII standard. The patriotic speeches, cultural programmes and games were organized. Prizes were distributed to the winners. All students received sweets and ice-creams sponsored by SIRRA. 20 MSW students taken active part and the Mrs. Laveena D'Mello coordinated the programme.
- 2. Vanamahostava":** Vanamahostava programme was organized by MSW department and NSS Volunteers of BBM department in collaboration with SIRRA at Srinivas Institute of Medical Science and Research Centre (SIMS&RC), Mukka, Mangalore. Dr. P.S. Aithal, Principal inaugurated the programme by planting a sapling. Mrs. Laveena D'Mello, Faculty MSW department, Ms. Deekshitha, NSS officer and Prof. Varadaraj of Srinivas School of Engineering was present for the programme. 50 Volunteers and students planted about 75 saplings on this occasion. This programme was collaborated with Forest Department and SIRRA Agency.
- 3. Regular Participation in SHG Meetings:** Ward sabha at kuthethur panchayath, Committee meeting at Billava sangha at Hejamadi, Sri Shakthi meeting in Shishumandira at Ganeshpra Ward Sabha at Kalavaru, Bala Panchayath, Hindu Dharmik youth club meeting at Mangalpete, Green star club meeting at Guttakadu, SHG meeting at Nadugodu, Ward sabha at kuthyar and padupadav panchayath, Moghaveer Sangha meeting at Meenakalya, Baikampady and Sri Shakthi meeting at Punarur, 19 members present for it.
- 4. Survey on Hyper tension (BP) and Blood Sugar:** Under SIRRA it was decided to promote health plan to cover around 2000 general population by conducting Survey on Hyper Tension (BP) and Blood Sugar in the area around Mukka in the month of February, March and April 2014. We covered 50% of our target.
- 5. Guest Lecture on HIV and Counseling:** Srinivas Institute of Management Studies, B Com Department students organized guest lecture for the student on 14<sup>th</sup> September 2014, and Mrs. Laveena D'Mello, was the Resource person. 80 students were present and they cleared their doubts.
- 6. Special Health awareness programme for women:** On 19<sup>th</sup> September a village meeting and awareness programme was organized at panchayat hall, Kilpady Mulki. The special health aspects related to women were addressed during the programme..

Panchayat Development officer, ANM, Anganwadi workers and the women from the community were present. Total 35 women participated in the programme.

7. **Dental camp:** on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2014, Dental camp was organized for Kotipalya School and community. About 70 people participated in the programme. Follow up was done by Srinivas dental college.
8. **Malaria Survey:** on 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2014 Social workers covered Mulki Nagar Panchayat area by conducting survey on Malaria, and this also included by providing information about the spread of Malaria, Cleanliness and providing information on precautions. About 120 houses were covered during the survey.
9. **Programme on“Crest for Kashmir”:** A programme was organized by the social workers in collaboration with Centre for integrated learning for the flood affected people at Kashmir. Students have taken initiative in charity and welfare activity for these affected people by collecting fund, old cloths and food items form the general public in the month of September.
10. **Survey at Industrial Area, Baikampady:** 86 MSW students and faculty were involved in a Survey on Health and ESI Benefits in small industries belt of Surathkal on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2014. This was undertaken jointly by Srinivas Hospital, Mukka and Small Industries Association. The survey is a pre runner towards registering all eligible workers in order to ESI benefits to them. 100 small industries covered during the survey.
11. **Swacha Bharath Cleanliness drive:** Involvement of faculty and staff for participation in “Swacha Bharath Cleanliness drive” has been initiated.
12. **Joy of Giving:** In the month of October 2014 the programme was organized by introducing Toy Bank for the poor and needy children. This programme was organized in collaboration with Centre for integrated learning. This innovative idea is to collect old toys from the rich and provide for the needy and poor children.
13. **Health and Hygiene for women:** on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2014, organized programme for Self Help Group Women at Anganwadi center, Matti, Kaikaba. 30 women were present. This programme was organized in the collaboration with Dharma Jyothi Social Work Centre, Vamanjoor. The resource person was Smt. Sujatha, community organizer, Vamanjoor.
14. **Youth clubs formation programme:** on 8<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> October 2014, at Mangala Nagar and at Jyothi Nagar (two programmes), youth clubs were formed in collaboration with Mangala Jyothi Integrated School, Vamajoor. 18 youth were present. The awareness is given on cooperation and strengthening of youth clubs.

15. **Training for Self Help group:** on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 at Yedurupadavu community, Moodushedde, Training programme was organized for women. 35 women were present. This programme was organized with the collaboration of Prajna Counseling centre, Attavar.
16. **Malaria Awareness programme:** on 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 at Babbarya temple Bolar community, Malaria awareness programme was organized for general public. 100 members were present. Dr. P.S. Aithal was the chief guest for the programme. This programme was organized in collaboration with KMC, Hospital, Mangalore.
17. **Health and Value education programme for SC/ST community:** on 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2014, a school awareness programme was conducted for High school children. 50 students were benefited from this programme. This programme was organized in collaboration with Centre for Integrated learning, Mangalore. The topics like cleanliness, basic hygiene, concentration in studies and the behaviour were included in the programme.
18. **Survey on Health Card:** On 18<sup>th</sup> October 2014, a survey was organized with collaboration of Srinivas Hospital, Mukka. This was conducted in Bikampady area. It covered whole industrial area. Follow-up of the survey was also done.
19. **Swachha Bharath Andolan Programme:** On 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014, the programme was organized for the public and 40 members from Kilpady Grama panchayat were present. This programme was organized at Kilpady community. Panchayat President, members, PDO and social workers were present for the programme.
20. **Inauguration programme of Urban Health Centre:** On 5<sup>th</sup> November, 2014, participated in Inauguration programme of Urban Health Centre at Surathkal. This centre is under Srinivas Hospital Mukka.
21. **Health awareness Programme:** On 7<sup>th</sup> November 2014, the programme was organized for the Government Pry. School, Kenchankeri, near Kilpady. 54 students were present for the programme. Mrs. Nirmala from Primary Health centre, Kilpadi was resource person for the programme.
22. **Awareness on Dental care and check-up camp:** on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2014, awareness on Dental care and check-up camp was organized at Government Hr. Pry. School, Kasababengare, Mangalore. 76 children are benefited from this camp. This programme was organized in collaboration with D.K. District Federation of Consumer Organization.

25. **Health check-up camp:** on 12<sup>th</sup> November 2014, Health check-up camp was organized at Government Hr. Pry. School, Thaneerubhavi. 30 children were covered and this programme was organized in collaboration with Srinivas Hospital, Mukka.
26. **Swachha Bharat Abhiyan and Child Sexual abuse programmes:** Two programmes were organized on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2014 at Bolar Anganwadi School, Mangalore. Child Sexual abuse and cleaning awareness programme were organized together. For both these programme 50 participants were present. This programme was coordinated by Mr. Pradeep M.D.
27. **Kitchen Garden and tarries farming:** on 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2014 at Moodushedde community the Kitchen Garden and tarries farming programme was organized for women. 30 women were present.
