

Report of the activities conducted for the year 2016-17

1. **Health check-up camp:** on 6th April 2016, Health check-up camp was organized at Spoorthi Dhama, Kundapura. About 100 deserving patients benefited from the camp. Follow up was done at Srinivas Hospital.
2. **Guest Lecture on Endo sulfur:** Under SIRRA banner, two days; on 21st June and 19th July 2016 two separate programmes were conducted on Endo sulfur and its effects on the general public awareness programme was conducted at Belthangady, kaniyuru. This programme was organized with the collaboration of District health department and the Srinivas Hospital. Students and social workers involved in giving publicity in the area. In the first programme 62 participants and in the second programme 95 participants were present. Tea and snaks were arranged under SIRRA.
3. **Medical camp:** On 31st July 2016, Medical camp was organized at CSI Unity Church Hall, Mulki. 86 patients benefited from the camp. All the department staffs were present and did the medical check- up, gave medicine and for few patents for further treatment and for follow were referred to Srinivas Hospital.
4. **Malaria Survey:** on 12th September, 2016, Social workers covered Mulki Nagar Panchayat area by conducting survey on Malaria, and this also included by providing information about the spread of Malaria, Cleanliness and providing information on precautions. Practical session and demonstration along with supply of Guppy fish was done during the programme, About 110 houses were covered during the survey.
5. **Free BMD camp:** On 17th September, 2016, Bone Marrow Density Camp was organized at Srinivas Hospital. This was conducted regular base in every month starting from 17th September, 2016, dates like 22nd October 2016, 19th November 2016, 17th December 2016, 21st January 2017, 18th February 2017 and 18th March 2017. Since it was free many patents were benefited from this camp. Around 185 patents have done their check-up free of cost. These camps were organized under SIRRA.
6. **Health Awareness programme on Endo sulfur:** Under SIRRA banner, two days; on 20st September and 18th October 2016 two separate programmes were conducted on Endo sulfur and Medical check –up was done at Belthangady, kaniyuru. This programme not only included the awareness but also Health Check-up for the patients who effected by Endo sulfur. The programme was organized by the District health department and the Srinivas Hospital. In the first programme 48 participants and in the second programme 75 participants were present. Refreshments were arranged under SIRRA.
7. **Joy of Giving:** In the month of October 2016 the programme was organized by introducing Toy Bank for the poor and needy children. This programme was

organized in collaboration with Centre for integrated learning. This innovative idea is to collect old toys from the rich and provide for the needy and poor children.

8. **Neuro Surgery Camp:** SIRRA organized Neuro Surgery Camp, with the collaboration of Jaya Clinic Padubidri, on 21st October 2016. 13 surgeries were conducted with the collaboration of Srinivas Hospital.
9. **Swacha Bharath Cleanliness drive:** Involvement of faculty and staff for participation in “Swacha Bharath Cleanliness drive” has been initiated at the Mangaladevi, Bolar and Pandeshwar area.
10. **Malaria Awareness programme:** on 15th October, 2016 at Babbarya temple Bolar community, Malaria awareness programme was organized for general public. 80 members were present.
11. **Teenage education Programme:** On 11th November, 2016, teenage education programme was organized at Government High School, Bodel, Mangalore. 120 students were present. The resource person was Mrs. Laveena D’Mello.
12. **Teenage education:** On 21st November 2016, programme was organized on the problems faced by Teenager at Government High School, Moodushedde, Mangalore. 60 students were present. The resource person was Mrs. Laveena D’Mello.
13. **Awareness on Health:** On 19th February 2017 Awareness on Health was organized programme for the Community people. Mr. Mathiew from community medicine, Srinivas Hospital, was the resource person. Around 140 people benefited from this programme.
14. **Training on Soft Skills:** On 6th March 2017, the Training on soft skills was organized for the Government High School, Shakthinagar community. 90 students benefited from the programme. Mrs. Laveena D’Mello was the resource person.



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
